AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Members of Board of Hairdressers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 1601, amended. The last paragraph of section 1601 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Each member of the board shall be allowed the sum of ~~\$20~~ \$50 per day and their necessary expenses for actual attendance upon any examination of candidates for registration and for any necessary hearings and board meetings.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

No state funds are necessary to implement this Act, as the fees collected under the Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 23, are the source for the needed funds.
