IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Fees Under State Nursing Law.

Be it enacted by the People or the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 2206, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 2206 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 206 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Such person shall complete the renewal application and return it to the board with a renewal fee of \$3 \$5 before December 31st of the year in which said application was received.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 32, § 2206, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2206 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Any registered nurse who allows his or her license to lapse by failing to renew the license as provided may be reinstated by the board on satisfactory explanation for such failure to renew his license and on payment of a reinstatement fee of \$5.58.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 32, § 2255, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 2255 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 206 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Such person shall complete the renewal application and return it to the board with a renewal fee of \$2 \$5 before July 1st of the year in which said application was received.

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 32, § 2255, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2255 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Any licensee who allows his or her license to lapse by failing to renew the license as provided may be reinstated by the board on satisfactory explanation of such failure to renew his or her license and on payment of a reinstatement fee of \$3 \$8.

- Sec. 5. R. S., T. 32, § 2256, sub-§ 3, amended. Subsection 3 of section 2256 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 3. Endorsement. By endorsement: Fee of \$5 payable on application and an additional fee of \$15 to complete the requirements for the issuance of the license.
