**AN ACT Providing for Maintenance of a Certain Road Leading to
Baxter State Park.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Maintenance of a certain road leading to Baxter State Park. The Maine State Park and Recreation Commission is authorized and directed to expend on the existing private road from Telos Landing in Township 5, Range 11 to the west line of Township 5, Range 10, said west line being a portion of the west boundary of the Baxter State Park, as much as shall be deemed necessary for the road's maintenance, including bridges and culverts, but not to exceed \$3,000 per year.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Park and Recreation Commission the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to provide for the purposes of this Act.
