AN ACT Relating to Taking Smelts for Bait Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2558, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2558 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

It shall be lawful to take minnows usually used as bait for fishing, other than the above-named species, for fishing in all the inland waters of the State during the period that such waters are open for fishing, as bait for fishing only in this State, except that the commissioner may grant permits to take minnows and smelts for bait purposes from certain waters at any time.
