COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 239, L.D. 294, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing An Act Setting Off Lands from Hartland to Pittsfield."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'An Act Setting Off Lands from Pittsfield to Hartland and Repealing An Act Setting Off Lands from Hartland to Pittsfield.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1852, c. 509, repealed. Chapter 509 of the private and special laws of 1852 is repealed, as follows:

Lands-set-off-from-Hartland-to-Pittsfield.--That-partof-the-farm-of-Warren-Fuller-in-Hartland,-upon-which-he-resides, is-hereby-annexed-to-and-made-a-part-of-the-town-of-Pittsfield.

Sec. 2. Lands set off from Pittsfield to Hartland. The following described land is hereby annexed to and made part of the Town of Hartland: Approximately 15 acres of land located in the Southwest corner of lot #5 in Hartland and Pittsfield, being bounded on the North by the Fuller Corner Road; on the East by the Town of Hartland; on the South by the North line of Range 5 in Pittsfield, also described as the Old Pittsfield-Hartland town line; and on the West by the Town of Hartland, being the same land now owned by Foster Brooks and Gerald Pease and formerly owned by one Warren Fuller.'
