IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Repealing An Act Setting Off Lands from Hartland to Pittsfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1852, c. 509, repealed. Chapter 509 of the public laws of 1852 is repealed, as follows:

Lands set off from Hartland to Pittsfield. That part of the farm of Warren Fuller in Hartland, upon which he resides, is hereby annexed to and made a part of the town of Pittsfield.
