COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 242, L. D. 297, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Disability Retirement and Retirement Allowances Under
State Retirement System."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 2 paragraphs
of section 1 (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'If the member has 30 years or more creditable service, has
not attained age 60 and whose application for a disability
retirement allowance has been approved, the 90% restriction will
not apply and the computation will be as provided by section 1121,
subsection 2, paragraph A.

Any recipient of a disability retirement allowance at the
effective date of this amendment shall be entitled to a review
and a recomputation of benefits and if this amount is greater
than that being paid then an adjustment shall be made, without
retroactivity, and shall become effective on the first day of
the next following month. Said recomputation shall be exclusive
of any adjustments made under the provisions of section 1128
and such adjustments shall not be changed, impaired or improved.'
