### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Exempting Water Supplied to Members of a Consumer Cooperative from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 3, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection 3 of section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

"Food products" shall include water supplied to members of a cooperative water system formed as a consumer cooperative in pursuance of Title 13, sections 1501 to 1531.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is estimated that the loss of revenue to the State under this Act would approximate \$500 per year.
