AN ACT to Clarify Certain Motor Vehicle Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 193, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 193 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The color, shape, size, lettering and numbering of such special plates shall be determined by the Secretary of State, except that plates issued to members of the ~~Legislature~~ **House of Representatives**, other than the ~~President of the Senate and~~ Speaker of the House, shall bear the number of the seat assigned to such member, ~~and except that plates issued to members of the Senate, except the President of the Senate, shall bear the number of the Senatorial District which the respective Senators represent.~~

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 244, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 244 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Trailers having a gross weight of 2,000 pounds ~~or more~~ shall be classified and rated as trucks. All boat trailers registered for a gross weight in excess of 2,000 pounds but not more than 4,000 pounds shall pay a registration fee of \$5.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 29, § 539, amended. The last sentence of section 539 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

~~The application shall contain a space for the applicant to list his blood type if he so desires.~~

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 29, § 1071, amended. Section 1071 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 46 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence: **“Sunrise” and “sunset” shall be the time given in the Maine Farmers’ Almanac.**
