COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 250, L.D. 305, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Renewals of Certain Occupational Licenses by

Amend said Bill in section 1 by adding at the end (same
in L.D.) the following underlined sentence: 'Such waiver of examination
shall not be granted if the registered barber served more than 4
years in the Armed Forces, except if he be required by some mandatory
provision to serve any longer period and he shall submit satisfactory
evidence thereof to the board.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by adding at the end
(same in L.D.) the following underlined sentence: 'Such waiver of
examination shall not be granted if the person served more than 4
years in the Armed Forces, except if he be required by some mandatory
provision to serve any longer period and he shall submit satisfactory
evidence thereof to the board.'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by adding at the end
(same in L.D.) the following underlined sentence: 'Such waiver of
examination shall not be granted if the person served more than 4
years in the Armed Forces, except if he be required by some mandatory
provision to serve any longer period and he shall submit satisfactory
evidence thereof to the board.'
