AN ACT Requiring Reconstructed Public Buildings Be Made Accessible to the Physically Handicapped.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2703, sub-§ 4, additional. Section 2703 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 367 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by adding a new subsection 4, to read as follows:

4. Reconstructed buildings. Plans to reconstruct, remodel or enlarge an existing building, when the estimated total cost exceeds \$250,000, shall be subject to this chapter, when, in the opinion of the administrative authority, the proposed reconstruction, remodeling or enlargement will substantially affect that portion of said building normally accessible to the public.
