STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT to Eliminate Moose River from the Maine Forestry District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1201, amended. The last sentence of the 8th paragraph of section 1201 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 34 of chapter 226 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Municipalities: ~~Moose River~~ Moscow, Brighton Plantation, Caratunk Plantation, Dennistown Plantation, Highland Plantation, Pleasant Ridge Plantation, The Forks Plantation, West Forks Plantation.
