STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Membership of Board of Trustees for Accident and Health Insurance Program for State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 285, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 285 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 543 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

2. **Coverage.** Each state employee to whom this section applies shall be eligible for group accident and sickness or health insurance as provided in Title 24, sections 806 and 2301, including major medical benefits. The provisions of such group insurance policy or policies shall be determined by a board of trustees consisting of ~~5~~ 6 members, 2 of whom shall be appointed by the Maine State Employees Association; one of whom shall be a retired state employee selected by a majority vote of the Presidents of the Chapters of the Retired State Employees Association; **one of whom shall be appointed by Council 74 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees**; and 2 state employees who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council. The board of trustees shall hold office for 3 years, with initial appointments to be made as follows: One member appointed by the Governor for 3 years and one member appointed by the Governor for 2 years; one member appointed by the Maine State Employees Association for 3 years and one member appointed by the Maine State Employees Association for 2 years; and one member, appointed by the Maine State Retirees, for one year. The master policy for such group insurance shall be held by the Commissioner of Finance and Administration who shall be ex officio a member of the board of trustees. Said group insurance shall be administered by the board of trustees herein provided.
