AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Certain Neat Cattle from Personal Property Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 655, sub-§ 1, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection 1 of section 655 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

C. Mules and horses less than 6 months old; colts of draught type less than 3 years old; neat cattle less than 18 month old **to the number of 25**; sheep to the number of 35 and all lambs under one year old; swine to the number of 10 and all swine under 4 months old; domestic fowl to the number of 50; goats to the number of 35 and all kids less than one year old.
