## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing the Salaries of the Boxing Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 8, § 101, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 101 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 14 of chapter 476 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Each member of the commission shall receive a salary of \$7,000 \$1,200 a year and his reasonable expenses, including transportation, incurred in the performance of his duties.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Boxing Commission the sum of \$1,050 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
