**RESOLVE, To Reimburse William E. Hodgdon of Embden for Well Damage
by Highway Maintenance.**

William E. Hodgdon; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to William E. Hodgdon of Embden for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route No. 201A in Embden.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

William E. Hodgdon's farm is located at the top of a hill south of the Solon-Embden Bridge on Route 201A. The present 16 foot rock well, located some 100 feet from the highway, has become contaminated from chloride applied to the road and stock piled at the crown of the hill by the State Highway Commission.
