COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 270, L. D. 346, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Duties of School Committees Concerning Salaries of  
Persons Employed by Them Who are Absent."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first sentence of  
that part designated subsection 10 (same in L. D.) and inserting  
in place thereof the following sentence:

'They shall have authority to adjust the salaries of teachers,  
principals and other persons legally employed by them who are  
compelled to be absent from their school duties ~~en-accunt-of~~  
illness but no reduction on pay may be made if absence is caused  
by the bona fide observance of designated holidays in the church  
of their faith.'
