IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Duties of School Committees Concerning Salaries of Persons Employed by Them Who are Absent.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 20, § 473, sub-§ 10, amended. Subsection 10 of section 473 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- ro. Salaries of persons absent. They shall have authority to adjust the salaries of teachers, principals and other persons legally employed by them who are compelled to be absent from their school duties on account of illness, personal business or religious reasons. This subsection and subsection 9 shall apply only in cases of persons who are employed on yearly contracts or on tenure of service and who hold the legal qualifications necessary for such positions.
