STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Approval of Secondary Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1281, sub-§ 10, amended. Subsection 10 of section 1281 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 335 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

10. Size. Any public high school enrolling fewer than 100 300 pupils may be approved by the State Board of Education on an emergency basis only after the school committee or board of directors have presented in detail reasons for such emergency approval. If the board finds that the school is geographically isolated, it may grant approval for a period not to exceed 3 years, contingent upon compliance with all other provisions of this Title.
