COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 279, L. D. 355, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Voting Residence of Wife of Member of Armed
Forces."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the word "Wife"
and inserting in place thereof the word 'Spouse'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part
designated "5" and inserting in place thereof the following (same
in L.D. 355):

'5. Spouse of member of Armed Forces. A spouse of a member
of the Armed Forces on active duty may have the same residence
for voting purposes as his or her spouse.'
