**AN ACT** Relating to Voting Residence of Wife of Member of Armed Forces.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., T. 21, § 242, sub-§ 5, additional.** Section 242 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 5, to read as follows :

**5. Wife of member of Armed Forces. A woman married to a member of the Armed Forces on active duty shall have the same residence for voting purposes as her husband.**
