IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Holding Property by Cumberland Farmers' Club.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1875, c. 75, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1875 is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2. Seal; may hold real and personal property; powers, privileges and liabilities. Said corporation is hereby established in the Town of Cumberland, County of Cumberland, with power to sue and to be sued, to use a common seal, and may acquire and hold property, real and personal, to an amount not exceeding five thousand dollars and shall have all the powers and privileges of similar corporations, and be subject to all the liabilities of similar corporations.
