STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hours of Sale of Liquor in Class A Restaurants, Hotels and Clubs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

No liquor shall be sold in this State on Sundays and no licensee by himself, clerk, servant or agent shall between the hours of midnight and 6 a.m. sell or deliver any liquors, except no liquors shall be sold or delivered on Saturdays after 11:45 p.m. and except that in **Class A** restaurants, hotels and clubs liquor shall be sold to 1 a.m.
