COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 124, L.D. 386, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to School Construction Aid."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R.S., T. 20, § 3457, amended. The 12th paragraph of section 3457 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 488 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding at the end the following sentences: In addition the board shall require that all projects approved for state aid under this section shall show evidence of the need for such facilities based on obsolescence or inadequacy of present buildings, assurance that existing facilities are receiving maximum use, enrollment projection for at least a 5-year period, financial ability of the unit, utilization studies and other information including but not limited to estimates of operating costs and effectiveness of educational programs related to proposed construction. In addition, projects approved for state aid shall show evidence that spaces within proposed structures shall be assigned a specific educational purpose, or are supportive of the educational program.'
