STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Town's Matching Funds for Reconstructing State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1104, amended. The first paragraph of section 1104 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 439 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

If any town shall in a single year increase its appropriation for state aid roads to an amount of 4 or 6 or 8 times the maximum amount which it may annually appropriate under section 1101 for use only in reconstructing improved state aid highways, the commission shall from any balance of said fund for state aid highways, and subject to section 1105, apportion a like increase of state aid.
