SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 307, L.D. 394, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Construction and Improvement of Airports throughout the State; for a Tourist Information Building at Kittery; a State Office Building; the Repair and Improvement of Certain State-owned Buildings; and Provide for other Essential Improvements to Facilities for the Departments of Adjutant General, Finance and Administration, Civil Defense and Public Safety, Health and Welfare, Veterans Services and the Maine Port Authority by issuing bonds in the amount of \$11,140,000."

Amend said Amendment by striking out in the last line of the first paragraph the figure "\$1,940,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$2,440,000'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the last line of the 2nd paragraph the figure "\$1,940,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$2,440,000'

Further amend said Amendment under the caption "MAINE PORT AUTHORITY" by inserting after the 4th line the following:

'International Ferry Terminal.....500,000'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out the figure "140,000" in the last line under the caption "MAINE PORT AUTHORITY" and inserting in place thereof the figure '640,000'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out the line
"TOTAL - STATE IMPROVEMENTS \$1,940,000"
and inserting in place thereof the line
'TOTAL - STATE IMPROVEMENTS \$2,440,000'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the next to the last line of the last paragraph the figure "\$1,940,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$2,440,000'
