COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 307, L. D. 394, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Construction and Improvement of Airports throughout the State; for a Tourist Information Building at Kittery; a State Office Building; the Repair and Improvement of Certain State-owned Buildings; and Provide for other Essential Improvements to Facilities for the Departments of Adjutant General, Finance and Administration, Civil Defense and Public Safety, Health and Welfare, Veterans Services and the Maine Port Authority by issuing bonds in the amount of \$11,140,000."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following Title:

'AN ACT to Provide for the Construction and Improvement of Airports Throughout the State; for a Tourist Information Building at Kittery; the Repair, Planning, and Improvement of Certain State-owned Buildings and Institutions and Provide for other Essential Improvements to Facilities for the Department of Adjutant General, Finance and Administration, Veterans Services and the Maine Port Authority by Issuing Bonds in the Amount of \$1,940,000.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line of section 1 (5th line of L. D.) the figure "\$11,140,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$1,940,000'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 6 and in inserting/place thereof the following:

The amount listed after each project is to be construed as a guide and, within departments or agencies, any one or more amounts may be exceeded with the approval of the Governor and Council as long as the total expenditures of state money do not exceed the total amount of the bond issue allocated for all projects of a department or agency. The amount transferred from one project to another shall not exceed 5% of the amount listed and no one project shall be reduced by more than 5%.

Bureau of Public Improvements Planning Funds.

Each recommended project shall be planned as a complete facility. Each project shall provide for drives, walks, grading, connections to required utilities, and allow for the purchase of all needed equipment and furnishings.

It is the intent of the Legislature that the preliminary plans

developed shall include necessary site information, floor plans and shall be sufficiently developed so as to fix and illustrate the size and character of the project. Outline specifications and a detailed estimate of construction cost predicated on these plans and outline specifications shall accompany the same. The above information shall serve as the basis for capital requests to the 105th Legislature.

The Bureau of Public Improvements will be provided with sufficient funds to allow the preliminary planning for the following projects:

Education Department - C.M.V.T.I. - English, science and class-room wing, dormitory addition; E.M.V.T.I. - Laboratory wing and dormitory; N.M.V.T.I. - One new dormitory; S.M.V.T.I. - Culinary arts building, electronic-electrical building and heating-air conditioning shop.

Maine Maritime Academy - Waterfront engineering building phase I.

Finance Administration - Bureau of Public Improvements - New office building and maintenance and service building.

Mental Health and Corrections - Augusta State Hospital - admission and intensive treatment building; Bangor State Hospital - construction of maintenance building; Pineland Hospital and Training Center - maintenance building; Boys Training Center - medical-psychiatric unit; Stevens School - all purpose building; Mens Correctional Center - inmate dining room and kitchen; Governor Baxter School for the Deaf - Pre-primary unit and diagnostic center.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the first 2 paragraphs of section 9 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 9. Referendum for ratification. The aldermen of cities, the selectmen of towns and the assessors of the several plantations of this State are empowered and directed to notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet in the manner prescribed by law for calling and holding biennial meetings of said inhabitants for the election of Senators and Representatives, at an election to be held November 4, 1969 to give in their votes upon the acceptance or rejection of the foregoing Act, and the question shall be:
