COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 310, L.D. 397, Bill, "An Act Appropriating Moneys to Provide Uniforms for Employees of Maine State Ferry Service."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the word "Uniforms" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Caps or Uniform Emblems'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970, for the purpose of providing caps or uniform emblems for employees of the Maine State Ferry Service.'
