#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Retention of Trading Stamps on Retail Purchases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 10, § 1252, sub-§ 1, additional. Section 1252 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 1, to read as follows:
- 1. Retention or trading stamps. Any person engaged in the issuance of trading stamps based on retail purchases shall be authorized to retain stamps on purchases of less than 4c or 4c over the even dollar amount. If said purchases exceed 5c or 5c over the even dollar amount, said stamps shall be issued to the customer subject to section 1256.
