# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Report of Insurance Companies of Fire Loss Adjustments to Insurance Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 25, § 2398, amended.** Section 2398 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 2398. Insurance companies to report all loss adjustments to commissioner.

Every fire insurance company or association transacting business in the State shall report to the Insurance Commissioner the following information for every loss in excess of \$500, within 10 days after the adjustment of every such loss; the amount of all policies issued by said company on the property destroyed or damaged, the amount paid or payable on account of such loss and such other information relating to the matter as the commissioner may require.
