## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Location of Office of Chancellor of the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1865, c. 532, § 4-A, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4-A of chapter 532 of the private and special laws of 1865, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 229 of the private and special laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The chancellor shall maintain his principal office in University of Maine owned facilities as were conveyed to the university by the Federal Government following the phase out of Dow Air Force Base in Bangor, and may have such other offices as the board of trustees may designate.
