AN ACT Relating to Bag Limit on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 12, § 2355-B, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2355-B, to read as follows:

§ 2355-B. Bag limit on bears

It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot, trap, take or kill, or have in possession more than one bear in any calendar year, except the commissioner may authorize the taking of nuisance bears.
