IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Construction or Acquisition of School Buildings for
Mentally Retarded Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3162, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 3162 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 360 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed as follows:

~~If the buildings from which county funds have been expended under this section shall not be used for the operation of such programs, the amount of funds expended by the county, or the land and buildings shall be returned to the county.~~
