AN ACT Providing for a Guest Fishing License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 2601, sub-§ 6-A, additional. Section 2601 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 6-A, to read as follows:
- 6-A. Guest license. Any resident of Maine domiciled in this State who is a riparian landowner in any lake, pond or river may purchase a guest fishing license. Such license may be used when the usual license is not readily available, used by such nonresident person as designated on the license by the person purchasing same. Said guest license shall be valid only on the lake, pond or river adjacent to which the property is located. The fee for a guest fishing license shall be \$15 and may be obtained from the commissioner or agents which he may designate.
