AN ACT Relating to Approval of Court Term Bills.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 751, amended. The last sentence of section 751 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 326 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed as follows:

~~No term of Superior Court shall adjourn until the presiding justice shall certify to the county treasurer that all expenses incurred during such term have been submitted for payment.~~
