HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 151, L. D. 432, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing Salaries and Duties of Liquor Commissioners Other Than the Chairman."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation and figure <u>'Sec. 1</u>.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 5 lines (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following: 'The salary-of-the-chairman-of-the-commission-shall-be-\$ll;000-per year-and-the salary of each of the other members, other than the chairman, shall be \$57625 <u>\$7,500</u> per year, and in addition each member shall be allowed his reasonable expense incurred in the performance of his duties, and they shall devote 3 working days per week to their duties.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following section:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, §55, sub-§5, amended. Subsection 5 of section 55 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

All purchase orders, vouchers, new listings and delisting orders shall be signed by at least 2 members of the commission.'
