## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries and Duties of Liquor Commissioners Other Than the Chairman.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 53, amended. The first sentence of section 53 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 228 of the private and special laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

The salary of the chairman of the commission shall be \$11,000 per year and the salary of each of the other members, who shall devote 3 working days per week to their duties, shall be \$5,625 \$7,500 per year, and in addition each member shall be allowed his reasonable expense incurred in the performance of his duties.
