STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of State Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 53, amended. Section 53 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 228 of the private and special laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 53. Salaries and expenses

The salary of the chairman of the commission shall be \$11,000 per year and the salary of each of the other 2 members shall be \$5,625 per year, and in addition each member of the 2 members shall be allowed his reasonable expense incurred in the performance of his duties when away from his home. Such expense shall not include travel between his place of residence and the commission office, or board and lodging in the city or town where such office is located or in the City of Augusta. The chairman shall be allowed travel expense between his place of residence and the commission office once each week.
