IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Revising the Construction Safety Law Enforcement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 45, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 45 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

If the commissioner or any authorized agent of the department shall find, upon inspection of construction activities, that conditions of the activity are in violation of the rules and regulations and or are in such condition so as to be dangerous to employees working at or near them, he shall notify immediately the contractor or person in charge of such activity to make alterations or additions consistent with the rules and regulations by him deemed necessary for the safety and protection of the employee.
