COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 338, L. D. 447, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing an Occupational Safety Rules and Regulations Board."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§564." by striking out all of the first underlined sentence of the 2nd paragraph (same in L. D. 447) and by inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'The board shall consist of 7 members of which 6 shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§564." by striking out all of the 4th underlined paragraph (same in L. D. 447) and by inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'In case of a vacancy in board membership, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, shall appoint a member of the proper classification to fill the unexpired term of the absent member.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the Statement of Facts, a new section to read as follows (same in L. D.)
'§569. Rules and regulations

The rules and regulations formulated under this chapter may supplement, but shall in no manner supersede, the rules and regulations duly promulgated by the Board of Boiler Rules, the Board of Construction

Safety Rules and Regulations and the Board of Elevator Rules and Regulations, whose rule making authority is clearly set forth in sections 173, 373 and 432, respectively.'
