SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 338, L.D. 447, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing an Occupational Safety Rules and Regulations Board."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§565." by striking

thereof the following underlined sentence (same in L.D.):

'The rules and regulations so formulated shall conform as far as
practicable to nationally recognized standards of industrial safety.'
