STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Members of Harness Racing Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 8, § 265, amended. Section 265 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 265. Compensation

The salary of the chairman of the commission shall be \$1,500 \$2,500 per year and the salary of each of the other members shall be \$1,200 \$2,000 per year, and in addition each member shall be allowed his reasonable expenses, including transportation, incurred in the performance of his duties.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Harness Racing Commission the sum of \$4,550 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
