COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 340, L.D. 459, Bill, "An Act to Grant a Council-Manager Charter to the Town of Orono."

Amend said Bill in section 206 by striking out all of subsection 2 (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. Forfeiture of office. A councilman shall forfeit his office upon final conviction of a felony or if he lacks at any time during his term of office any qualifications of the office prescribed by this charter or by law.'

Further amend said Bill in section 601 by adding at the end (same in L.D.) a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The associate member shall act in the stead of a member who is unable to act because of interest, physical disability or temporary absence from the State.'

Further amend said Bill in section 702 by striking out in the last line (last 2 lines in L.D.) the words "or is convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude," and inserting in place thereof the words 'or upon final conviction of a felony.'
