COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 366, L.D. 476, Bill, "An Act Relating to Registration and Licensing of Dogs on Indian Reservations."

Amend said Bill in subsection 1 by inserting in the 4th line (same in L.D.) after the underlined word "<u>tribes</u>" the underlined words '<u>and all other persons</u>'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 2 by striking out in the 8th line (8th and 9th lines in L.D.) the underlined comma and words ", and any member of said tribes" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'capable of bearing young. All female dogs shall be considered capable of bearing young unless a certificate issued by any licensed veterinarian stating that such female was made incapable of bearing young by spaying, or any previous license record so indicating, is presented. When such certificate or record accompanies the application a fee of \$1.25 shall then be paid on such spayed female. Any member of said tribes and all other persons residing on said reservations'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 5 by striking out in the 3rd line (2nd line in L.D.) the underlined word "<u>May</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word '<u>June</u>'
