STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Mileage Allowance for State Employees on State Business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 8, amended. The first sentence of section 8 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The State shall pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the State in the buisiness of the State not more than <u>9e 12c</u> per mile for the first 5,000 miles actually travelled by such employees on such business in any one fiscal year and 7e for each mile exceeding 5,000 miles, except that the State shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes or table stock potatoes ge for every mile so traveled.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$30,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and the sum of \$40,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 for carrying out the purposes of this Act.
