COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 767, L. D. 987, Resolve,
Relating to Fishing in Robbins Pond, Aroostook County.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the Title the
following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, fishing is one of Maine's greatest natural resources
and tourist attractions; and

Whereas, conservation of fish for both the inhabitants of
Maine and our summer visitors is vital to the economy of the State;
and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety, now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Resolve shall take effect when approved.'
