SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 373, L.D. 482, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Secondary School Tuition."

Amend said Bill in the 5th, 6th and 7th lines (4th and 5th lines in L.D. 482) by striking out the following: "Said per pupil cost shall be increased by 7% the same percentage increase that occurred in the per pupil cost in the unit during the preceding year, and in" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Said per pupil cost shall may be increased by 7% up to 15%, provided that the per pupil cost so charged shall not exceed the actual per pupil cost for the current fiscal year, and in'
