STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Establishing an Advisory Committee on the Governor Baxter State School for the Deaf.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 34, § 2908, additional. Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2908, to read as follows:

§ 2908. Advisory committee

The Governor shall appoint an Advisory Committee on the Governor Baxter State School for the Deaf which shall consist of 6 members and shall appoint a chairman. Of the first appointments 2 shall be for one year, 2 for 2 years and 2 for 3 years, and thereafter, appointments shall be for 3 years.

The committee shall advise with, and assist, the Superintendent of the Governor Baxter State School for the Deaf in matters pertaining to the operation of the Governor Baxter State School for the Deaf, and the conduct of its educational program.
