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### AN ACT Relating to Tuition Charges for Pupils Attending the Governor Baxter State School for the Deaf.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 34, § 2906, amended. Section 2906 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 2906. Costs

For each child admitted to the school, the town in which the child is entitled to school privileges in accordance with Title 20, section 859 shall pay to the State, to be credited to the General Fund, an amount equal to the per capita cost of instruction and equipment in a public elementary school for a normal child in that town pupil cost, excepting cost of residence at the school, computed and reported as provided in Title 20, section 3117 for administrative units and private schools.
