STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting License for Certain Maine Residents in Armed Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 2301, sub-§ 5, additional. Section 2301 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 5, to read as follows:
- 5. Hunting licenses for Maine residence in Armed Forces. A resident hunting license shall be issued, on payment of \$1, to a Maine resident in the Armed Forces of the United States who is stationed outside the State and who is in Maine on leave or furlough, and such license shall be valid only for the duration of his leave or furlough.
